Age 76, of Brooklyn Park, passed away suddenly on Dec. 9, 2024.

Pat was born on July 18, 1948 in Minneapolis, MN. She was the first of seven children born to Bernard and Anne O'Donnell. She graduated from Regina High School in 1966 and went on to study Nursing at St. Mary's Junior College in Minneapolis.

Pat enjoyed a remarkable 47-year career as a Registered Nurse.
